TO THE ARTIST PRESENTER:

Thank you so much for sharing your art with these non-professional artists at this Wisconsin Regional Art Program (WRAP) Workshop. Here are some recommendations for your presentation.

Select a topic of interest to the group – Discuss with coordinator(s)

Use demonstration, digital images (ask if this equipment is available) or actual artworks to illustrate talk

Discuss the schedule and time allotted for your presentation with the coordinators (s)
Plan for a question/answer period in that time

OPTIONAL - Assist the Juror in the critique session. Discuss this possibility with the coordinator(s) first.

GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT WRAP

The Wisconsin Regional Art Program began in 1940 as an outreach program of UW-Madison to recognize and encourage nonprofessional artists. In 2020, WRAP's 80th Anniversary year, the UW-Madison Division of Continuing studies was forced to eliminate their support of WRAP due to budget reductions. The Association of Wisconsin Artists (AWA) has assumed the administration of the WRAP program, which is now affiliated with the UW Department of Art.
